

Everything [all, U, the universal set] is the same size. There is no scale.

Because there is no scale, there is total uniformity in size with everything. All matter, all energy, all objects and non-objects, all that is known and unknown are no longer differentiated by their size: horses are the same size as ants, molecules are the same size as galaxies, volumes are points, zero becomes infinity.

Mass disappears. Nothing is large, nothing is small. Nothing can be measured. There is no spatial cardinality. Concepts such as tiny, gigantic and equality have no meaning because there is no possibility of comparison.

Because there is no scale, space collapses. With the disappearance of space comes the elimination of shape. There is no geometry. Structure loses its quantitative essence. Every object has the same proportion as every other object. Everything is isomorphic. The sum of every thing and its separate parts are invariant and are no longer independent.

There are no dimensions. Nothing is separate from anything because that which previously separated things is the same as that which it separated. Depth, boundaries, perspective and relativity vanish because there is no empirical perception of any elements. Because there is no space, nothing has a position and nothing can be perceived as having a direction. Nothing expands, nothing contracts. There is no place except the entirety of all.

Everything is now one conceptual and actual framework that exists in a perfect absolute totality of uniformity.
